August 21, 1959 – Hawaii Becomes the 50th State

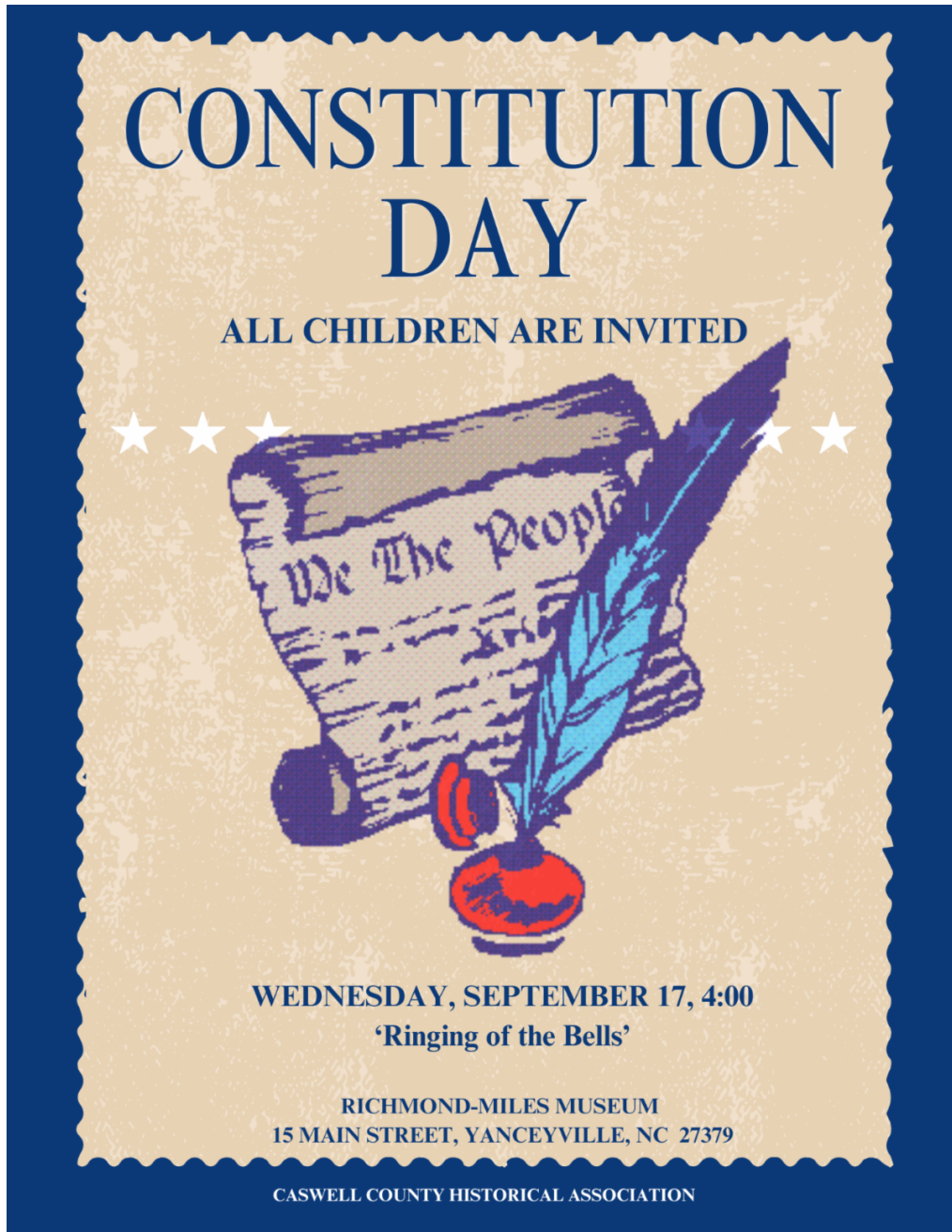
